Introduction

In 1773, Mozart wrote the canons and harmonies for a musical composition he designed. The idea is to use the random outcomes of dice rolls to create a Minuet.

This can be an implementation of that game. The canonic and harmonic parts for the game appear to have been composed and arranged by Mozart himself, so the original title of the work is "Mozart's Musikalisches Würfelspiel".

There are 50 possible Minuet measures and 50 possible Tonic measures to choose from. The result of a die roll is looked up in a table of values to determine which measure is chosen.

You should be able to play it demands only 14 of the 16 Minuet measures (the 21 possibilities for each of the first two measures) and 10 of the 16 Tonic measures (the 21 possibilities for each of the first two measures). So there are 14 x 10 = 140 possible combinations. Of course, many of these will be ruled out. Nevertheless, there are still many interesting possibilities.

Compose a Minuet

Please, click on the "Minuet" button below the score.

The computer generates the random numbers and places you the resulting pieces (the "Mozart" button) below them.

1. Click the "Minuet" button to start the game.
2. Click the "Mozart" button to see the resulting piece.
3. Click the "Score" button to see the score.

NOTE: This version of the game uses the same random number generator as the original. So the same Minuet pieces will be generated every time you click the "Mozart" button.


